Tilos by Antonio Citterio

The Tilos Collection takes inspiration from the archetypal seating of the 1950s and 1960s, traditionally crafted in bamboo and rattan. These forms have been reimagined using advanced technologies and modern industrial manufacturing techniques, resulting in a collection that feels both timeless and contemporary.

At its core, Tilos features a distinctive shell made of metal and woven acrylic rope, designed to cradle plush cushions while ensuring both comfort and durability. This shell rests on a structural frame available in either wood or metal, offering a refined and versatile foundation. The design seamlessly allows for the interchangeability of these base materials, adapting to different aesthetic and functional needs.

The collection also includes dining chairs available in two versions—one stackable for greater flexibility and another with armrests for enhanced comfort.

With Tilos, the goal was to merge tradition and innovation, seamlessly blending artisanal references with the precision of contemporary industrial craftsmanship to create pieces that integrate effortlessly into modern spaces.







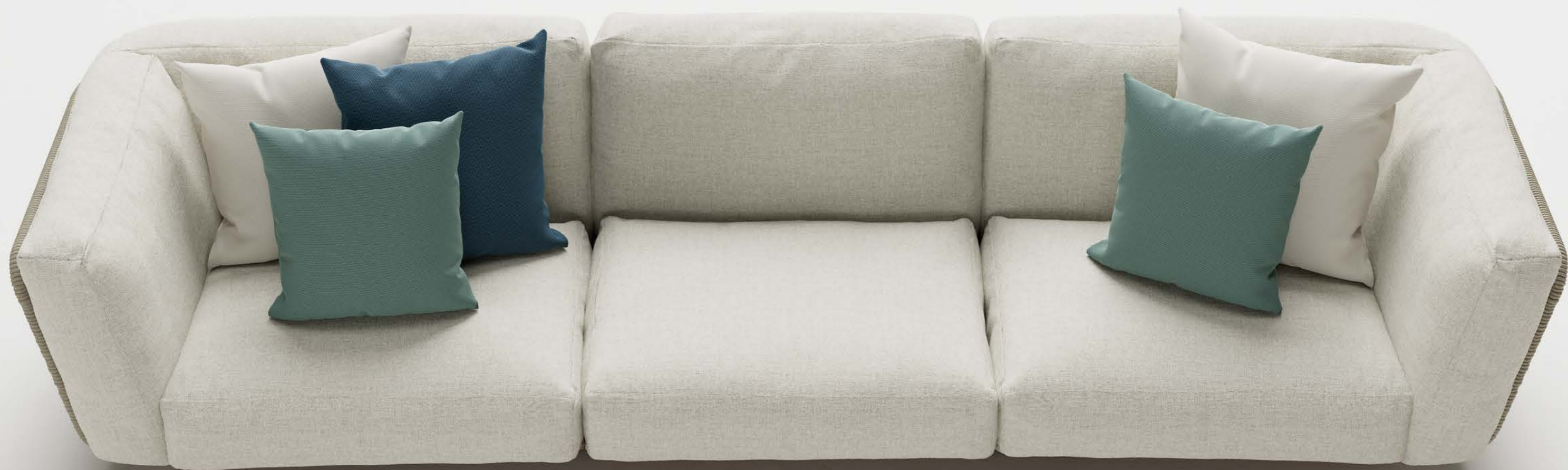






































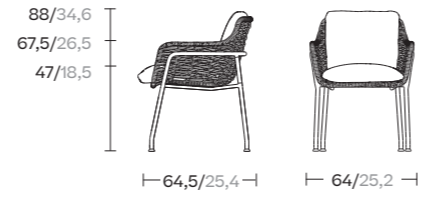

Loden, by Vico Magistretti

Kettal revives the LODEN collection. Originally designed for Gavina in 1961, Loden is a series featuring an armchair and a sofa with a lacquered wood frame made with four cylinder-section legs and a tilted seat, also made of wood, with curved armrests whose design is similar to the profile of the armrests of the Carimate chairs. The seat and backrest are upholstered in fabric. Dino Gavina, a Bolognese businessman, started

producing new furniture in the mid-50s by collaborating with well-known designers and put back into producing furniture by Breuer, a renowned designer in NY, like the Cesca and Wassily chairs. The Loden series by Magistretti is part of the collections produced by Gavina in the 60S”







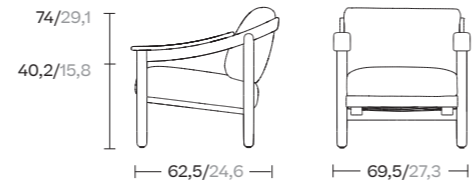






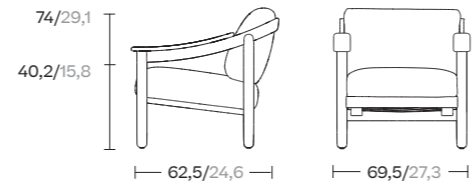

Designed by Konstantin Grcic, the Kari collection features a pair of highly versatile side tables that can be combined in countless ways. While both tables share a circular top, their bases explore two distinct geometries: cylinders and pyramids.

Currently available in teak wood, their clever construction allows for a wide variety of materials to be used. The geometric

shapes lend the pieces an elegant, African-inspired character and a natural aesthetic.

Kari tables serve as practical side tables or occasional seating next to a sofa or armchair. Their lightweight design makes them easy to move around as needed.







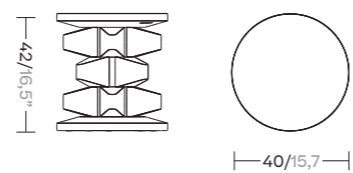

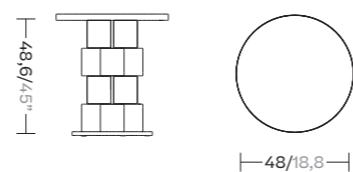

Designed as sculptural islands, Ínsula tables by Patricia Urquiola find their identity in the delicate balance between the organic and the refined. Each piece stands as an autonomous object, capable of interacting with its surroundings through its unique presence.

The tabletop, finished in Glaze Agate —a glaze with hypnotic depth and mineral tones— brings a rich, sensory dimension to the piece. Its surface, layered with subtle variations, evokes geological formations and natural processes, as if time itself had crystallized in ceramic.

Soft, fluid lines contrast with the visual density of the glaze, creating a dialogue of textures that invites both touch and contemplation. More than a table, Ínsula is a material experience — a meeting point between contemporary craftsmanship and poetic design.

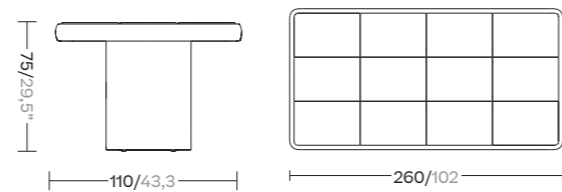






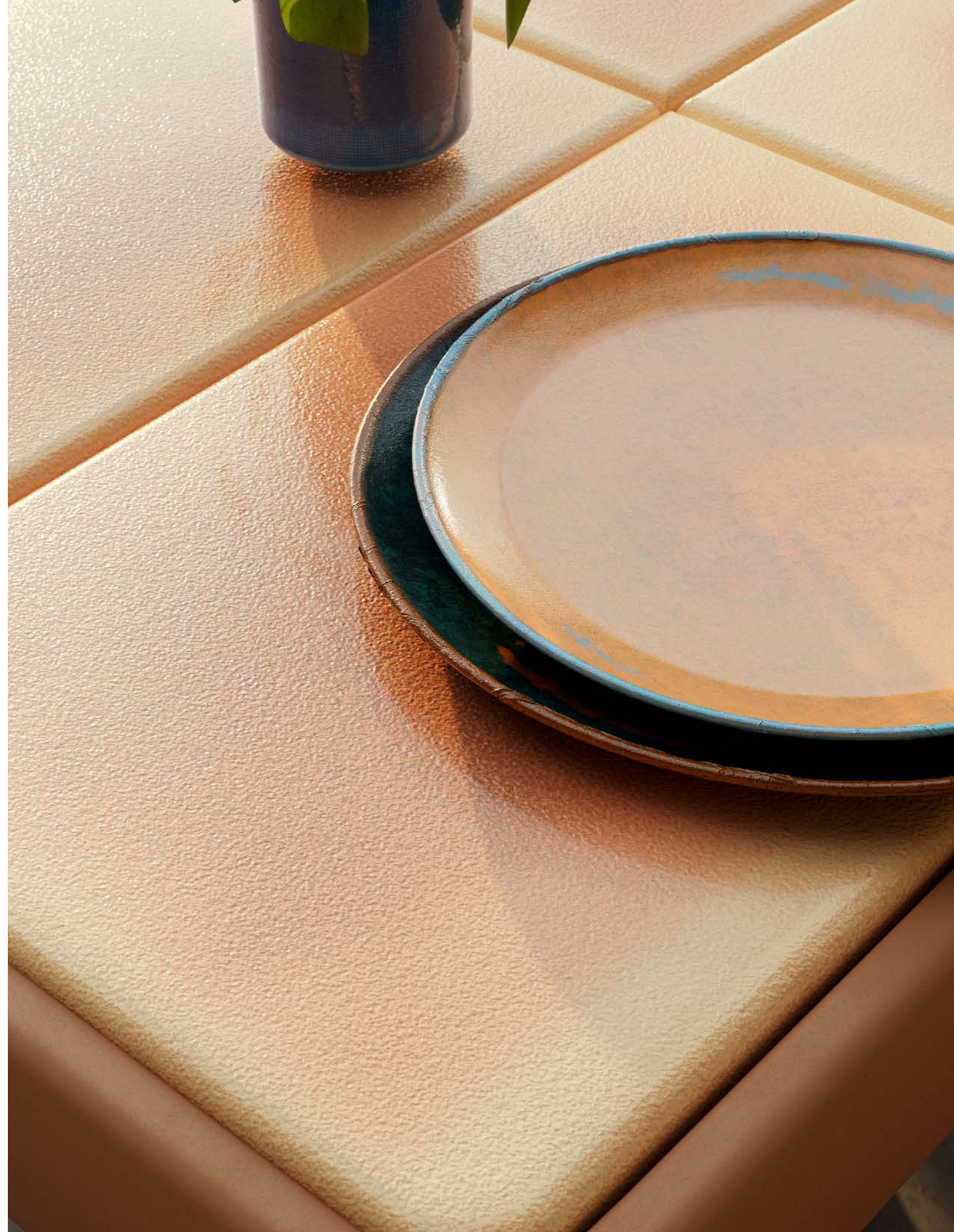
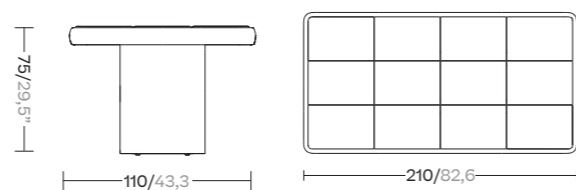

Its configurations are grouped into three main categories: Focus, for concentrated work; Meet, for communication and idea exchange; and a third adaptable option for other functional needs, such as printing stations, kitchen areas, and more.

Pi not only helps define spaces but also enhances acoustic comfort by reducing noise and absorbing disruptive sounds from the environment. Its units can be spontaneously used as phone booths, video conferencing rooms, reading corners, quiet coffee

spots, or meeting rooms—without the need for enclosed spaces.

Its orthogonal “H” shape design allows for easy spatial structuring. Installation is quick and seamless, without generating noise or altering the building structure. Additionally, the units can be combined, expanded, or adjusted to accommodate changing workspace needs.

Pi is made from recycled PET panels, a lightweight yet durable material that not only helps reduce noise but also adds a sophisticated aesthetic and a pleasant textile-like feel.
